2018/2019 SEASON

Welcome to the 2018/19 cricket season. The Marist College Canberra Cricket Club exists to provide an effective cricket support infrastructure for Marist students to play cricket and develop their cricket skills and interest in the game.

Goals

- To provide all students at Marist with the opportunity to play cricket.
- To maximise the level of participation of students who choose to play cricket.
- To provide qualified coaches for the College's cricket teams.
- To provide all players with the opportunity to be coached in all facets of the game.
- To educate Marist cricketers in the etiquette of the sport and ensure that coaches and players play the game accordingly.
- To develop all teams, and especially the 1st XI, into successful combinations where all boys are able to contribute to a team's success.
- To keep the College and general community informed of the progress of its cricket teams.
- To maximise the level of satisfaction students gain from playing cricket so they will want to play the game 'next year'.
- To assist with the running of junior cricket in the ACT.
- To encourage Marist players to play in representative teams.
- To ensure that funding is available to achieve all other goals.

How are teams run?

Volunteers are essential for the support and future of Marist Cricket. Please mark the appropriate box when you complete the on-line registration form if you are able to coach, manage, umpire or score this season. Training and accreditation for coaches will be available during the season. Please note: it is now a mandatory requirement for all volunteers to have a Working with Vulnerable People card.

What about tryouts for teams?

The team grading process will take place in August/September. Players are not graded in Under 10s. If we have more than one team in the same division of any age group, teams of equal capability are selected.

What age does my son have to be to play?

Boys can play cricket from Year 4 to Year 12. Depending on date of birth (see table below), your son will play under 10s or 11s in Year 4 or under 12s or under 13s in Year 7. It is the College and Club's policy that all boys play in their correct age group (although boys who would otherwise be under 9 would play two seasons in the under 10 age group).

Boys not at Marist in Year 3 or Year 6 who gain enrolment for next year are encouraged to play for Marist this coming season. See 'When is Registration' below.

When is the season?

The season will commence in early October (dates to be confirmed). Play will break in mid-December for the Christmas holidays and recommence at the beginning of February 2019. The season will finish in early March 2019.

When will my son play?

While scheduled playing times are not known until closer to the start of the season, an indication is provided below. Please note: some age groups will also be scheduled to play mid-week T20 matches.

Do I have to provide any cricket gear?

For health and hygiene reasons, players are required to supply their own helmet and protector. All other items will be provided in the team cricket kit. Players may use their own equipment (bat, pads, gloves, etc) if they have it, but it is the player's responsibility to look after it at the ground. Wearing of helmets is compulsory for all batsmen regardless of age at both training and matches.

What do players wear?

All players are to observe the dress requirements for Marist Cricket, i.e. official playing shirt embroidered with the College crest, white/cream trousers. The Club's playing shirt is long sleeved and rated 50+ SPF. Players should wear the Club's broad-brimmed cricket hat or Marist cap. These items are available only from the College's Uniform Shop. Players may wear sunglasses, provided that they do not interfere with their game.

Registration

All things being equal, registration will open in early July. Please keep an eye out on our website for the link to our on-line registration form and instructions on how to use it.

Fee Structure

Our fees for the 2018/19 season have not yet been endorsed but shouldn't change from last season:

- Single player- \$150
- Second player from the same family - \$100
- Third and subsequent player from the same family - \$50 each
