

## Instructions to connect to the Marist College Wi-Fi using MacOS 10.x

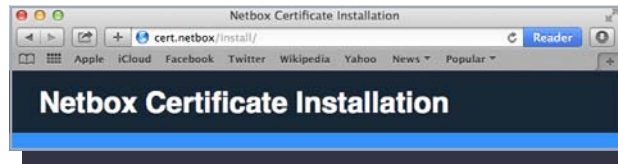
From the list of Wi-Fi networks, select **mcc\_g**



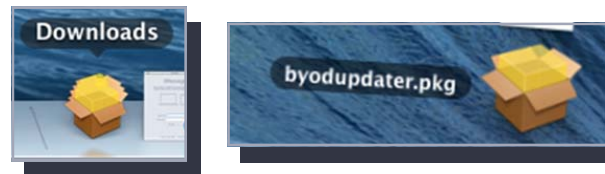
Enter your **College ID** in the "Username" field, and your password in the "Password" field. You may also want to select "Remember this network"



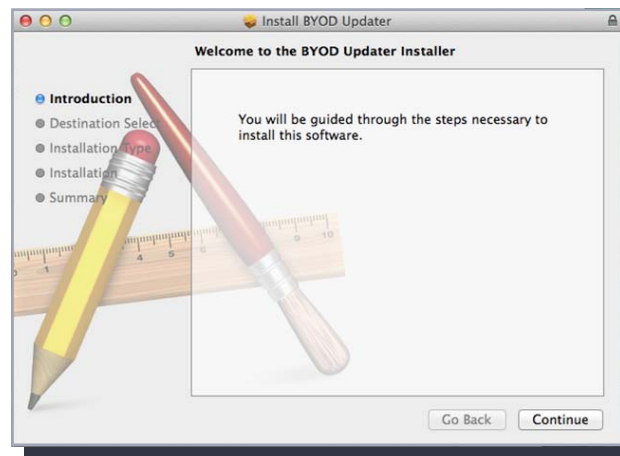
Open Safari. If the page illustrated below does not automatically appear go to the URL <http://cert.netbox/> - it should tell you that the 'Certificate was not found'. Download the Mac OS X certificate installer.



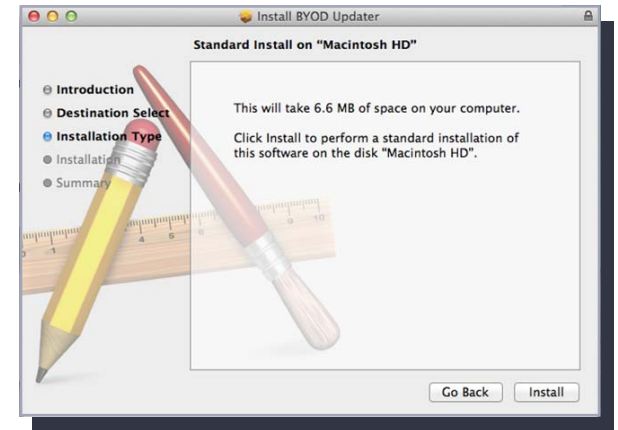
Run the byoupdater.pkg package from your Downloads folder



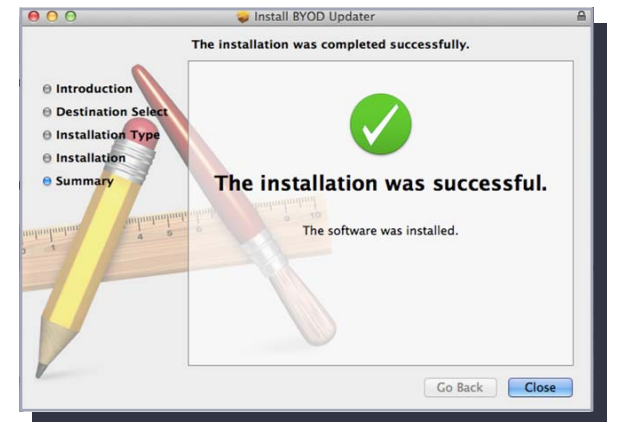
The BYOD Installer package should open. Click "Continue"



Click "Install"



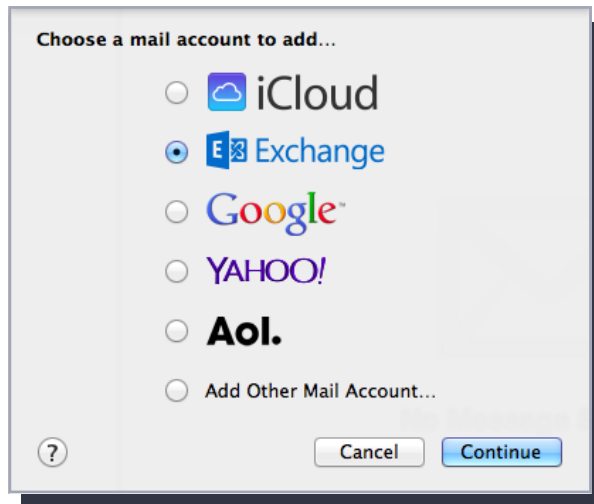
Click "Close"

# Instructions to Connect your Marist Email to your MacOS 10.x Mail application

Open Mail (or go to Settings → Internet Accounts) and select “Exchange”

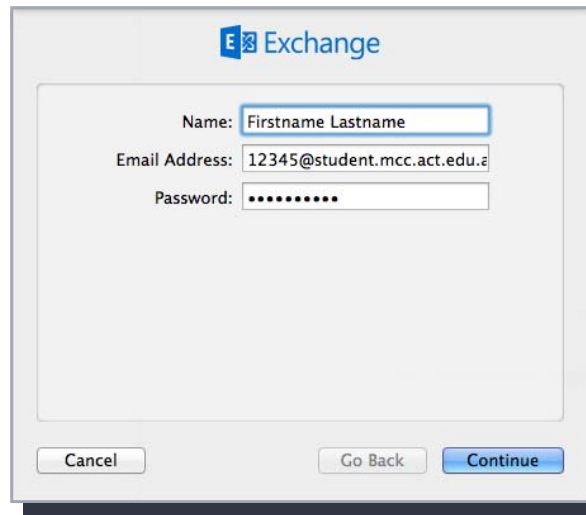


Enter your first name and last name in the “Name” field.

In the “Email Address” field enter your full College email address in the form **studentid@student.mcc.act.edu.au**

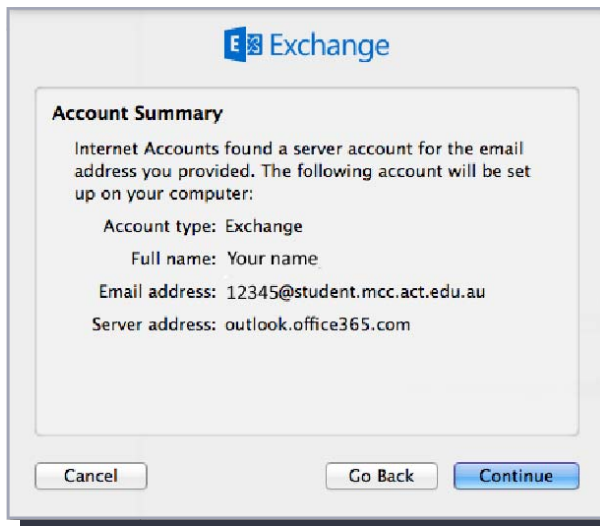
Enter your college password in the “Password” field.

Click “Continue”



Your device should then proceed to pull in the required information automatically

*If it does not your Domain\username is your full College e-mail address, and the server is outlook.office365.com*



Select the apps you want to configure to work with your College account. (which apps you choose is completely up to you)
