Overview

Vocational courses offered by Marist as the Registered Training Organisation (RTO)

- Retail A/V
- Construction Pathways A/V
- Furniture Construction A/V
- Hospitality A/V
- Information and Cultural Services A/V/M

Some students apply to do a vocational course and take up an Australian School-based Apprenticeship (ASBA). These students combine one paid day of work each week with their work in the vocational course. The student, employer and the training organisation (RTO) work together to ensure that the student works towards the achievement of their certificate. The student is expected to do 8 hours minimum in the workplace each week when doing a Certificate II level course.

Australian School Based Apprenticeships (ASBA) are available with Marist College as the Registered Training Organisation:

- Retail A/V
- Construction Pathways A/V
- Hospitality A/V (Hospitality - Operations)

Marist students may also access ASBAs where they undertake training through another Registered Training Organisation (RTO):
