Criteria for Teaching Positions

The College Mission, “to make disciples of Jesus Christ, educated and equipped for any future” lies at the heart of our teaching and learning process. The College expects its teachers to embrace this mission, model appropriate behavior, and through the teaching and learning process, encourage our students to reach their potential.

All applications for positions at Northside Christian College will be screened under College policy. In addition to selecting teachers who are strong in the content of their teaching areas, the selection criteria for teaching positions include identifying demonstrated:

- Passion for challenging and engaging students
- Christian commitment
- Commitment to developing young lives in a Christian culture
- Ability to cultivate high academic standards
- Willingness and ability to actively lead co-curricular activities
- Ability to thrive as a part of a team of professionals
- Ability to teach from a Christian worldview
- Ability to exhibit Northside Christian College’s genuine Christian commitment and care for students.

As part of the application process, you are required to provide the following documents:

- Curriculum Vitae
- Personal Profile for Teaching applicants (completed form)
- Statement of Faith (signed form)
- Evidence of Qualifications (certified copies)
- Current Queensland Teachers Registration Details
- Current, written Pastor’s reference, including testimony to Christian commitment.
