



2019 FEES AND CHARGES SCHEDULE

KINDERGARTEN TO YEAR 12

FEES PER ANNUM

The School's Annual Tuition Fees will be charged as follows:

The School fees for Kindergarten to Year 11 each year will be levied by four equal charges. Year 12 School fees are levied by three equal charges.

Family Concession: A reduction of **20%** of the Tuition Fee is made for the second student of the family attending the School, **35%** for the third child and **75%** for each subsequent student of the family attending the school **in the same calendar year**. The concession is system-generated in a chronological order using the children's ages. **The family concession does not apply to Pre-Kindergarten.**

School fees are charged on a Termly basis at the start of each Term. Payments being due 14 days after the start of each Term.

Payment options are available and must be approved through contacting the Accounts Department:

- Yearly. A 5% discount will apply to any Tuition Fees that are paid for a full year within fourteen (14) days of the start of Term One. (Does not apply to Pre-Kindergarten.)
- Termly. Normal Termly payment due 14 days after the start of each Term. Payment can be made by Direct Debit, Credit Card, BPay or the Parent Portal.
- Monthly. February to December on 8th of each month by Direct Debit or Credit Card.
- Fortnightly. Can be paid by BPay or the Parent Portal.

APPLICATION FEE

An Application for Admission Form must be completed and a non-refundable fee of \$100 (including GST) must be paid. This fee is applied to the administration costs associated with enrolments and interviews. Please note that the payment of this fee does **not** guarantee enrolment.

ENROLMENT FEE

Confirmation of enrolment is dependent upon an interview at a time and date to be nominated by the School, and upon the payment of an Enrolment Fee at the time the place is offered. This fee is non-refundable and is to secure your child's place at the School. This fee is **not** deducted from the first term's tuition fees. The Enrolment Fee for the first child is \$750, plus \$300 for the second child and \$200 for the third child enrolled from the same family to a maximum of \$1250.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME (YEARS 7 TO 12)

Additional Assistance and Clothing Allowance Scheme: The Department of Education & Training in WA funds a High School clothing allowance and an Additional Assistance Scheme for students. Conditions apply. Applications are to be submitted through the School before 12 April 2019. For more information relating to this Scheme please contact the School Accounts Department.

STUDENT NOTEBOOK FACILITY FEE

A device levy is charged termly to all Year 4 - 12 students to cover the cost of providing a Notebook and services to each student.

CAMPS

Camps are compulsory as they are part of the curriculum and all students will be charged. Prices vary per year group but to a maximum of \$450.

RESOURCE FEES

Levied to meet the costs of providing equipment, insurances, licenses, materials, selected publications and computer software and other resources that complement the delivery of the School's academic programme.

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT FUND

All families are required to contribute to the School Development Fund as a condition of entry. **The NON-VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION** is calculated on the following basis: \$350 for the eldest child, and \$120 for every other child attending the School **in the same calendar year**. The Development Fund does not apply to Pre-Kindergarten.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

It is compulsory for students in Years 3 - 9 to participate in Co-Curricular activities organised by the School or community groups. Some of these School activities may involve a cost. This is available online through the Parent Portal and the activity will be charged to the parent directly.

BOOKLISTS

Booklist items are available online via the Parent Portal. These are to be directly purchase online from OfficeMax. Some subscription charges will be billed to the School fee accounts.

EARLY LEARNING STATIONARY LEVY

For Kindergarten to Year 2 a stationary levy of \$100 will be added to the School fee account in Term 1.

SUBSCRIPTION CHARGES

Various subscription charges will be added to the School fee account.

METHOD OF PAYMENT OF ACCOUNTS:

School Fees may be paid by Cash, Cheque, BPAY, Direct Debit, Eftpos, MasterCard, American Express, Visa or online by Parent Portal. Please note that payment by Credit Card will attract a 1% surcharge.

OTHER FEES AND CHARGES

Charges will apply to non-compulsory events/items students attend. For example, Year 12 Ball, Leavers Jackets/shirts, reward excursions.

OVERDUE ACCOUNTS & PENALTIES

All School Fees must be paid within fourteen (14) days of Statement Date unless you have entered into an agreed payment arrangement after which a late fee of \$100 will apply to accounts which remain overdue.

In addition, should a payment be dishonoured for families on payment arrangements, a \$50 charge will be levied to the account on each occasion the payment is dishonoured.

A further **\$100 per month penalty fee** will be billed to outstanding accounts on a monthly basis while the account remains in arrears unless alternative arrangements have been made.

As per the Parent Agreement the School reserves the right to refuse a student to begin a new term without first obtaining the written consent of the Principal of the School, unless the previous Term's fees, levies and charges are paid in full, or a formal arrangement acceptable to the School has been made with the Principal.

Students may be invited to take part in School trips which are extra curricular in nature being both educational and recreational, for example the School's annual ski trip. For those students who wish to participate in these trips, there is a significant financial cost to the families involved over and above their normal school fees. In order for a student to be able to attend an extra curricular activity, their school fee account will need to be fully up to date or a suitable payment plan in place.

WITHDRAWAL NOTICE

The School must be given a full Term's notice prior to the withdrawal of a student from the School. In default of such notice, a quarter of the annual tuition fee will be charged in lieu of notice. To avoid fees in lieu being charged, notice of a student's withdrawal must be received by the School by the first day of the School Term preceding the Term of the student's departure.
