COMBINATION LOCKS FOR YEAR 7-12 LOCKERS

All students from Year 7 to Year 12 are required to purchase a master keyed combination lock from the School with which to lock their locker. This model of combination lock has a master key so that a locker can be opened by the Associate Principal of Sub-School in special circumstances (e.g. parents requesting work to be sent home to a student who has chicken pox and therefore access to the locker is necessary).

Due to the master key provision through the spine of the lock they cannot be bought independently; and must be supplied through the School.

Students are reminded to take care with the lock, as all lockers are expected to be locked with the School combination lock (with master key facility). In the event of losing, destroying or breaking the lock a student will be required to purchase another one through the relevant Sub-School Reception. Conversely, students taking care of their combination lock can use it for many years without any further cost.
