

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

The School's Instrumental Music programme is open to students of all ages. Professional tutors come into the School and conduct instrumental lessons once a week during School time.

To supplement the instrumental programme, all students involved in woodwind, brass and drum lessons will become members of the School band, vocal students will become members of the school choirs, and string players will become members of the relevant string ensembles.

In Year Five, students are given the opportunity to learn a band instrument in a programme with an orchestral focus. Students will be able to choose an instrument from violin, cello, orchestral percussion, flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet or trombone. In their classroom music lesson, students combine with all of their instruments, to form a Year Five Concert Band.
