SUN PROTECTION AND THE SCHOOL UNIFORM

The School is an officially recognised Sun Protection school under the auspices of the Cancer Council of Australia. The School's students are able to be informed of the daily UV rating, as the School has a Cancer Council approved UV meter installed at the School which instantaneously posts readings to the School's Learning Management System.

The School's sun hat policy and sun protection complies with the Cancer Council's requirements. All students must have their sun hats at school on every school day.

Kindergarten to Year 6 students are required to wear the school sun hat whenever outdoors.

Middle and Senior School students are required to wear the School sun hat when the UV rating is 3+.

Students are also encouraged to apply sunscreen regularly, which is available at all Reception areas and in the Gymnasium.
