WAVES CAFE

POLICY

The Waves Café is located in the Creative Arts building, opposite the entrance to the Allan Shaw Centre and is used by the whole school. The purpose of the Café is to provide a selection of reasonably priced healthy and nutritious foods. The Café is not subsidised by the School and the prices are kept to a minimum but set at a level that will cover all of the operational costs in offering the service to the school.

WAVES CAFÉ GUIDELINES AND POLICIES

The Waves Café seeks to achieve an appropriate balance between the preferences and demands for various types of food and drink and promoting the sale and consumption of healthy food. A menu is made available at the beginning of each Term via the School Portal.

Food prepared for Primary School students is made in accordance with the 'Traffic Lights School Canteen' policy that is enforced within the cafeterias of State Schools. This policy aims to promote the consumption of healthy food.

Similarly, the Waves Café does not sell any fried food, with its potato wedges being baked in the oven. Canned soft drinks are only available as part of specific fund raising activities or events and chocolate bars and other similar confectionery are not sold.

Due to the concern about the consequences of students with allergies suffering anaphylactic reactions to certain foodstuffs, most typically nuts, the Waves Café does not use or allow the sale of peanut butter and/or 'Nutella'. Satay style foods are prepared using nut free products. It is important for students, families and staff to be aware that the Waves Café is unable to guarantee food is 'nut-free', or free of other substances that may cause an allergic reaction. Accordingly, the School encourages members of the School community with any such allergies to be sensible and vigilant when purchasing food from the Café. Recess

During Recess, Middle and Senior School students may purchase items directly from the Café.

Lunch

Middle and Senior School students may either order lunches at the Wave Café on their way into School in the morning, or purchase over the counter.

Primary School students may order their lunches online from the Waves Café via www.flexischools.com.au. Lunches will be delivered to the classrooms at the start of lunch. Orders must be placed by 8.20am each morning.
