BUS ETIQUETTE

Students are to remember that when travelling on a bus, behaviour is to always be of the highest standard. When on a bus, students are publicly demonstrating standards and behaviour to the community at large. They should ensure that they follow the bus driver's and their teachers' direction at all times.

- Teachers should complete a roll call before entry onto bus (at all times).
- Seat belts to be worn at all times.
- Seating on bus as per regulation and bus safety rules (ie. Years 7 onwards - 2 per seat).
- All passengers are to face the front of the bus with legs forward, not to the sides of the seat facing the aisle.
- Passengers are to remain reasonably quiet while bus.
- No one is to move seats while the bus is in motion.
- There is to be no inappropriate body contact on the bus.
- No part of the body is to be extended from the bus window at any time.
- Nothing is to be thrown around the bus or from the bus window at any time.
- Bags are to be stored below passenger's feet at all times.
- Students are to follow teacher directions at all times.
