



2019 Tuition and Boarding Fees

Application Fee:	\$55 per student (non-refundable) when an Application for Enrolment is submitted.
Enrolment Deposit:	\$400 per student - paid on acceptance of enrolment as per PLC Standard Agreement <u>OR</u> \$600 per family

Term fees are issued four times per year and due dates for payments are:

Term 1 2019 – Friday, 1 February 2019

Term 2 2019 – Friday, 26 April 2019

Term 3 2019 – Thursday, 18 July 2019

Term 4 2019 – Friday, 11 October 2019

- Failure to pay fees by the above dates or not honouring your payment arrangement will result in cancellation of enrolment. For further details please see our [School Fees Credit Policy](#)
- The fees currently listed are reviewed annually and are subject to change.

Tuition fees per student:

Please note the below fees include hire of textbooks, workbooks, diary, compulsory camps and excursions, swimming lessons (Prep to Year 10), school sport affiliation fees, subject levies, Yearbook (one book per family), art council performances and school excursion transport.

Family concessions are available on tuition fees only, as follows:

Boarding fees per student – Years 7 to 12:

Boarding fees are *additional* to the tuition fees listed above.

Boarding fees per student *include* accommodation, meals, laundry service (*for school uniforms only*) school and sport transport, weekend activity transport and some recreational activities.

Payment Options:

OPTION 1:

Full year's fees paid in advance **receives a 3.5% discount on net tuition fees only** paid prior to **1 February 2019**.

OPTION 2:

Fees paid per term by the first Friday of each term (term fees are issued four times per year).

OPTION 3: (Please contact administration to arrange)

Fees paid via direct debit either weekly, fortnightly or monthly instalments over the year.

Please note direct debit arrangements need to be paid in full by the end of November each year.

Additional Fees:

The following additional fees are *not* covered in the tuition and boarding fee payments and are the responsibility of the parent.

Additional Fees for all Students – Day and/or Boarding:

Bus transportation to and from school (Day Students only)

If the student(s) is a day student and elects to use the Bus Service for transportation to and from school, the following will be charged:

Per Child	\$360 per term or \$1,440 per year
Per Family	\$550 per term or \$2,220 per year

Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Program for Year 7 to 12.

Peace Lutheran College has a BYOD program in which students from Year 7 to 12 are required to bring their own devices. Please refer to the [ICT Information Booklet](#) for further information.

Voluntary Building Fund Contribution - \$25 per term for each child.

Additional Fees for Boarding Students only

Medical Expenses

Student health cover may not cover the full cost of doctors or specialist visits and does not cover medications and pharmaceutical costs. These extra costs are added to the school accounts as required.

Vacation Transportation

All beginning and end of term transportation (including transportation to and from the College) is the responsibility of the parent outside of the school's designated **drop off** time to the airport at the end of each term.

Pocket Money \$30 per week

Parents are responsible to ensure that their child has enough pocket money for the term. Parents are encouraged, if possible, to open an Australian bank account, and provide their child with a debit card. It is recommended that students boarding allow approximately \$30 per week for extra expenses for personal items and activities.
