CONCERT BAND WOODWIND & BRASS GROUP TUITION

Information form

This document provides important details concerning the structure of the group tuition Program at Peace Lutheran College. This program has been designed with a focus on performance within the safe/learning environment of a College Concert Band.

Instruments:

- Flute
- Clarinet
- Bass Clarinet
- Alto Saxophone
- Tenor Saxophone
- Trumpet
- Trombone

Beginners - no experience required

- Small group instructional 30 min lessons for beginners and experienced players are provided during school time using a rotational timetable. Students from years 4-12 only are able to access this program.
- Students are required to bring their instruments with relevant books and musical equipment to their lesson. Instruments can be stored in the music store room to ensure its safety or your child's classroom.
- It is the student's responsibility to be punctual to their weekly lessons. If there are any changes to lesson times due to school events (e.g. Swimming Carnival, Book Week activities etc., family or personal engagements e.g. doctor appointments, funerals, weddings, etc.), the instrumental tutor must be informed prior to the student's lesson day via email from the student's parents/caregiver to the instrumental tutor.
- If an instrumental tutor requires a change to students scheduled lesson time, students will be notified prior to their lesson day.
- If a student is unable to attend a lesson due to unexpected illness, their parent/caregiver must email the instrumental tutor by 8.30 am. If a student falls ill during the school day and will miss their instrumental lesson, then it is the parent's responsibility to pass this message onto the instrumental teacher personally or email before scheduled lesson time.
- If a student does not attend their lesson without prior notice to the instrumental tutor, the lesson will be forfeited. In this circumstance, the instrumental tutor will notify parents.

Costs Involved:

- Group lesson instrumental fees are \$18.00 per ½ hour lesson, which will be invoiced directly by the school with your school fees. Tuition and instrument hire fees will be invoice at the start of the school year in line with normal college tuition fees. Please note that if a situation occurs where your child can no longer continue in the program throughout the school year, a refund will be provided upon formal notification from parents.
- Please contact the College Administration if you experience any financial difficulties and we can make other arrangements, which better suit your needs.

- Parents/caregivers will also be responsible for any additional equipment needed, e.g. tuition books, reeds, strings etc.

Practice:

- Progress on any instrument is dependent on regular practice. Students are encouraged to play their instrument every day. In today's busy world, an efficient practice routine is "GRAB 5 MINUTES" 2-3 times a day instead of missing practice if a longer time slot is not available due to other routine weekly commitments.
- HOME HINT to get more practice out of your child – buy an instrument stand to prevent packing up the instrument. Often the biggest enemy to practice is putting it together from out of the case.

Performance Opportunities: Concert Band & Small Ensemble

The College aims to offer a variety of opportunities for students to perform on their instruments. This includes both college and community events throughout the year. Students will be required to participate in the college CONCERT BAND once they have gained enough basic skills on their instrument to do so. Concert Band rehearsals will take place every Tuesday morning between 7.50-8.55 am for continuing students. Beginner students will be required to join Junior Band on Wednesday mornings starting in Term 2 – 7.50am before school rehearsals.

College Hire Instruments:

College owned instruments are provided as an inexpensive way to find out if your child is going to enjoy playing a particular instrument. Hire instruments are \$50 per term, which is invoiced along with term fees. ***Loan periods are strictly for one year. After this you will be required to purchase your own instrument so younger children also have the opportunity to learn. There are options, including renting from a shop or buying second-hand, if you do not wish to buy brand new.*** You are required to complete a loan form before these go home.
