

ENROLLING AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT AT REDEEMER LUTHERAN COLLEGE

Send completed the International Enrolment Form, a photocopy of the student's passport, certified copies of the student's School reports for the previous two years, the information requested about the student's English language proficiency, details of where the student will live (either with an approved family member or in a College-arranged Homestay) and the non-refundable Application fee of AUD500 to the College's International Registrar.

The College will assess if the student meets the Entry Requirements and advise.

If the application is accepted, the College will send a Letter of Offer, a Written Agreement and an invoice.

If the student's English language proficiency is below that required, he/she will be required to undertake an intensive English language course before beginning mainstream studies. If this is the case, the College will issue a Conditional Letter of Offer and recommend a suitable English Language Centre.

Return the signed Written Agreement and pay the full invoice amount.

Upon receipt of the fees and the signed Written Agreement, the College will issue a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) and a Confirmation of Appropriate Accommodation and Welfare (CAAW) if the student is to be placed in a College-arranged Homestay.

Student uses the CoE (& the CAAW if applicable) to apply for their Student Visa.

While awaiting outcome of visa application, Homestay Application form is completed and sent to the College.

Parents and College communicate about the accommodation and subject selection etc

Once visa approved, flight details are given to the College and pick-up is arranged.

Host family brings student to College for their Orientation and first day. Welcome!
