

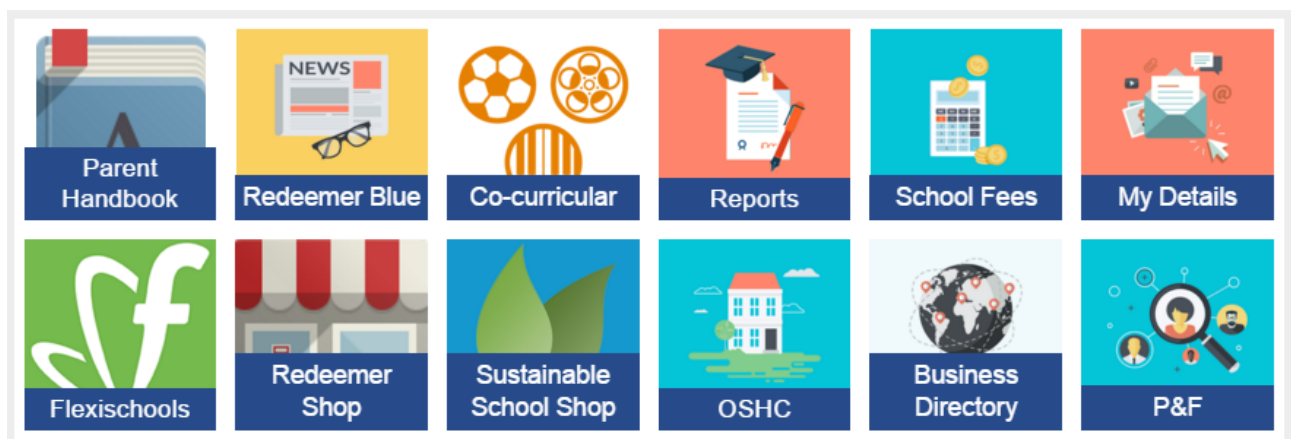
MyRedeemer

A new parent portal experience in 2016

Redeemer Lutheran College has had a significant overhaul of its online portal interfaces. We have combined all of our online services into a “one-stop-shop” with a single sign-in environment to access all of the information you need at your fingertips with a product called 'Schoolbox'.

There is now just one link from our website via the [MyRedeemer](#) link to a single portal experience for parents, students and staff. We anticipate that families will find it much easier to navigate to find the information they require and have easier access to the students' Learning Management System (LMS) interface. Schoolbox replaces My Big Campus.

At MyRedeemer you will find a user friendly dashboard with the following components:



There are also links to news items, the college calendar and your student's timetable, calendar and due work. MyRedeemer will become your one place to visit for all of the information that you require as a Redeemer parent, with the majority of information now coming to you via MyRedeemer.

Logging into MyRedeemer

1. Go to: my.redeemer.com.au (or access this link from the 'Portals' link at the top of the Redeemer website or on the Redeemer App).
2. Enter your Redeemer User name (5 or 6 numbers which can be found in the footer of all emails sent from Redeemer Lutheran College).
3. Enter your Password. (If you have forgotten your password, you can retrieve it by clicking on the "Forgot your password" link).

Our Learning Management System (LMS)

MyRedeemer also hosts our Learning Management System (LMS) that teachers use to provide resources, learning experiences and an online community outside the classroom. The LMS also acts as an entrance point to a wider Virtual Learning Environment (VLE). The extent to which a student operates on a wider VLE beyond the college's LMS will depend upon the age of the student and functionality that other web tools offer teachers and students.

Students and parents will have access to relevant resources and pertinent information for each of their classes or year level.

Prep – Year 2 students and parents will have access to:

- Links to literacy, numeracy, subject areas and extension resources and activities
- Class related news and info for parents
- Term overview

Years 3 – 6 students and parents will have access to:

- Links to literacy, numeracy, subject areas and extension resources and activities
- Class related news and info for parents
- Term overview
- Social stream or forum
- Homework published by 4.00pm each day

Years 7 – 12 students and parents will have access to:

- Their timetables
- Course or unit overview with information about assessment
- Provision of key resources, learning experiences and extension opportunities
- Provision of assessment tasks (not exams)
- Homework published by 4.00pm each day

Other Features

- **Reports** – Access your child's most recent reports simply by clicking on the "Reports" button at the top of the page.
- **School Fees** – View your current account balance and statements relating to your school fees.
- **My Details** – Check the current details that we have on file for each of your children at Redeemer. You can also update your contact details and child's medical details here.
- **News** – Read all of the latest news from the College in one spot.
- **College Calendar** – Access all of the upcoming calendar events at the College. You can also filter the calendar and only view specific events or items relating to a particular sub-school.
- **Timetables** – View your child's timetables, calendar and due work.

Future Developments

Submission of tasks

At the moment there are a number of different ways in which students submit work with regards to hard copies, drop folders or emailing. Consistent protocols for the submission of work will be developed during 2016. In Years 7 – 12 students must have their work checked for authenticity with Turnitin or Schoolbox's plagiarism checker.

Redeemer Blue newsletters

Our weekly newsletters, 'Redeemer Blue' will take on a refreshed new look this year with the aim of being a little easier for parents to sift through all of the important information for parents. Redeemer Blue will be incorporated within our website.

A new Redeemer website

While, the majority of information for current Redeemer parents will now be available at MyRedeemer, our existing website is currently being refreshed and upgraded. The new Redeemer website which will be available towards the end of Term 1, will be much more user friendly on mobile devices.

Redeemer App

Our Redeemer App will also be upgraded throughout Term 1 and will be integrated with Schoolbox.
