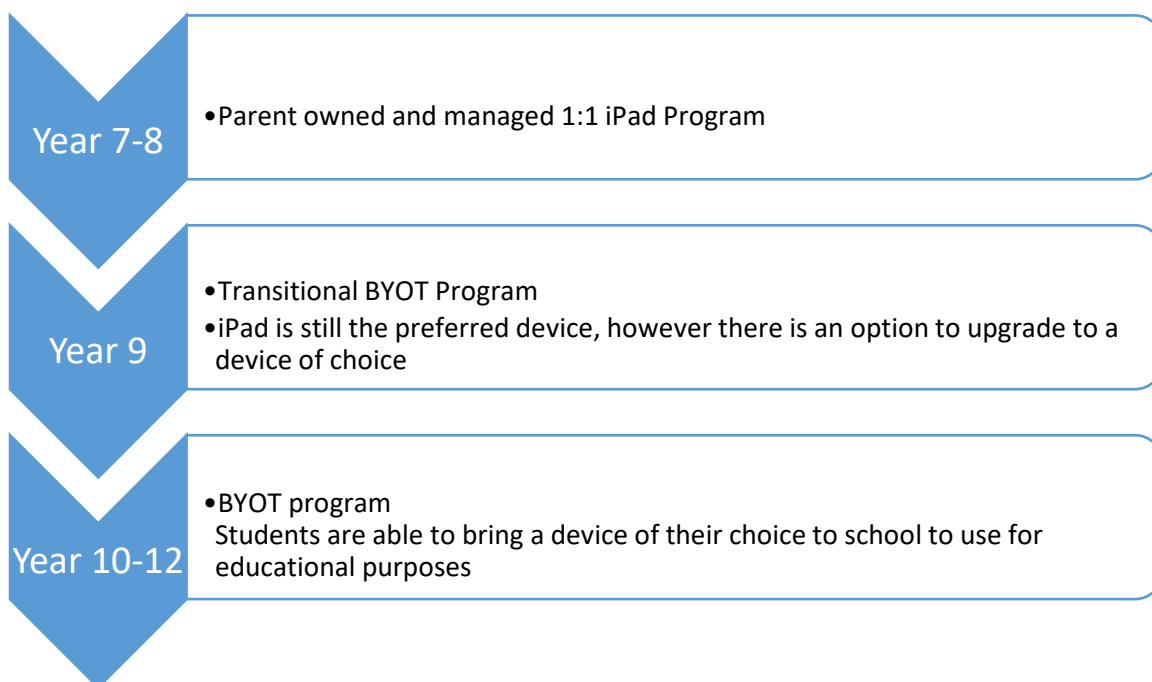


Information Technology Requirements Years 9-12

St Andrews Lutheran College operates a parent owned BYOT – “Bring Your Own Technology” environment in the Middle and Senior Schools. Under a BYOT program, students are able to connect a technology device of choice to the College WIFI and access electronic College resources. Allowing students to choose their preferred device enables them to work with technology they are already familiar and comfortable with. It also encourages greater responsibility of their device. As BYOT allows students access to the same devices at school and at home, it can extend learning opportunities to times and places outside of the classroom.

It is compulsory for all students to bring a device to school for educational use.

The College’s IT device pathway for Middle and Senior School is listed below.



Microsoft Office 365 is provided free to students to use on their own device. Microsoft OneNote (which is part of the Office 365 suite) is a compulsory install on all student devices as this forms part of the College Learning Management System.
