- Payment of OSHC Vacation Care Fees is required by the Monday of each week. If you do not have a direct debit account set up your fees will be payable via EFTPOS on the morning of your child's first session

## Children Information



- All children are required to wear **closed in shoes, sun-safe clothing and a hat**- no exceptions!!! (Your child/ren will not be accepted without these items)
- Please bring a water bottle (This is a pre-requisite for excursion days where water is not always available)
- Apply sun screen to your child before arrival (sunscreen is available at the OSHC service or children can bring their own labelled sunscreen 50+)
- Label all of your children's belongings
- Healthy Food: Fruit, yoghurt or a healthy snack for morning tea and a healthy lunch to be provided for children. Please keep treats at home as we follow the Healthy Eating Guide. Children with Anaphylaxis attend OSHC so please do not send your child with nuts or egg products.
- Afternoon Tea is provided by the service for the children at Vacation Care. Menu displayed in the kitchen.
- If any medication is required to be administered, then a medication form needs to be completed. Please speak to the OSHC Service Leader. All medication with required forms is to be given to the Service Leader prior to your child's first day at vacation care. Please do not leave any medication in children's bags.
- Technology: - Please note that children are **NOT** permitted to bring along their technology devices (IPADS, DS, IPODs, Laptops) to OSHC. Mobile Phones are also not permitted at the service. If you require your child to keep their mobile phone with them then this will be stored in the OSHC office until such time as your child is collected. Children are not given permission to make phone calls/text from personal mobile phones whilst in the care of OSHC. If children need to call parents - they can for important matters call from the OSHC landline with the permission of the OSHC Service Leader. Parents can leave a message on 07 55 225 762 and OSHC Educators will communicate to children any changes in pick up or collection.
