




- Assist with the Chairs of Faith in Action, Music and Culture and Sport; providing support, access to resources, options and solutions within the wider Lauries community
- Coordinate the activities for Lauries Sports Day and other combined events
- · Work with the Heads of House to assist with event planning and coordinate the support they require


SLC Community Committee Secretary

- Meet as required with the director of Faith in Action and extended faculty to assist in the shaping of event requirements and information gathering to communicate to the wider Community Committee

Work directly with and report to the Director of Sport to assist with:

- Event planning
- Raising funds for the equipment and services identified and prioritised by the Director of Sport in conjunction with the individual heads of sport
- Meets monthly with the Director of Sport, and parent volunteers to coordinate event planning and create two way communication between sporting faculty and engaged parents/carers

College boardroom or the library, depending on the number of attendees.


Optional attendees
