Bricktober is a project of the The Rotary Club of Ascot (Inc) and supported by The West Coast LEGO User Group- Funds raised go towards support for programs for young children and other Rotary and community projects. All funds raised go towards setting up Lego Play Groups and other Rotary and community projects. The main beneficiaries of the event have been:

- Set up and funding of 20 clubs that offer the "LEGO ® Play Experience" to children with a focus on children with Autism
- Support for The Rotary Foundation that funds and develops programs around the world, helping to achieve world understanding and peace through international humanitarian, educational, and cultural exchange programs. The world eradication of Polio is one of the fund's main projects.
- The Rotary Club of Ascot has, in the last 7 years, developed the supply of fresh drinking water to communities in East Timor Leste.
- Funding a Interpaste team of Doctors that travel to developing countries and perform surgery on locals affected by suffering deformities, like hair lip and burns.
