St Mark's Tuition Fee Assistance Plan

The St Mark's Tuition Fee Assistance Plan has been introduced to assist families who may experience financial challenges due to unforeseen personal and economic circumstances.

All School families are able to approach the School in confidence at any time to enquire and/or request support through the Tuition Fee Assistance Plan. The School will also be willing to consider arrangements for alternate payment plans during short-term financial difficulties.

Once the School has received a request for possible assistance, the School will set up a confidential appointment with the Bursar to discuss the family's personal circumstances. Following this meeting, a formal request for support may be submitted, at which time the family may be required to provide supporting documentation in order to fulfil a means test.

A decision on a request for support will be made as quickly as possible, and an appropriate Assistance Plan will be set up for the family. The Tuition Fee Assistance Plan will be reviewed annually.
