What is Student Assistance (STAS)?	Student Assistance provides assistance for low-income families towards the cost of school resources. STAS is provided through College resourcing rather than payment direct to families. From 2015, Catholic sector schools now directly assess eligibility for assistance to families and queries for assistance need to be directed to the College.

How to apply step by step

Step 1	Read the information on Page 2
Step 2	Complete personal details of you and your partner, if you have one. (See Page 3)
Step 3	Complete details for all your dependent children
Step 4	Complete taxable income details for you and your partner
Step 5	Attach proof of income for you and your partner. (See Page 2 for <i>acceptable proof of income</i>)
Step 6	Read and sign the Declaration and Authorisation section on the back of the Application Form. (See Page 4)
Step 7	Lodge the completed form and required information at the College or scan and email to fees@stpatricks.tas.edu.au

If I am an independent student, how do I apply?	Independent students who are under 18 years of age and are submitting an application are required to provide proof of the independent status. Independent students are generally: supporting themselves; receiving a Centrelink payment and meet the Centrelink independence criteria. Proof of independent status can be in the form of a copy of their current Youth Allowance or ABSTUDY notice of assessment that must clearly indicate the student is independent. Other acceptable evidence of independent status is a letter by a student counsellor or social worker. If independent status is not provided this will delay assessment of your application.

How do I know if I am eligible to apply?	From 2015, Catholic sector schools directly assess eligibility for assistance to families, and all queries for assistance need to be directed to the College. To be eligible you and your partner's gross taxable income must be no more than the figures shown in the income test table below. You must have a minimum 50% care of a child for them to be considered your dependent. Part-time students in special circumstances may be eligible if an application is supported by a statement from a student counsellor. Grandparents raising children are also eligible to apply for and receive STAS.

<p>How can I prove my major source of income and what will I need to provide?</p>	<p>You and your partner (if you have one) must be able to provide proof of your taxable income for the 2018-2019 financial year. Evidence of all income, including both Centrelink payments and any wages earned needs to be supplied.</p> <p>Proof of all 2018-2019 taxable income can be provided in the following ways:</p> <p>Centrelink Benefits other than the Family Tax Benefit;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your and your partner's Centrelink Customer Reference Number (CRN) • A copy of your Pension Card; or • A copy of your Health Care Card <p>Earned Income – attach a copy of your and your partner's;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2019 Notice of Assessment from the Australian Taxation Office; or • Three recent consecutive pay slips <p>Department of Veterans' Affairs – (DVA) attach a copy of your and your partner's;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DVA Income Statement; or • DVA Pension Card <p>Grandparents raising grandchildren – must provide evidence of your formal relationship with the student(s) by providing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your Centrelink Customer Reference Number (CRN) • A copy of your Pension Card (with the student/s listed) or • A copy of your Health Care Card (with the student/s listed) or • A Statutory Declaration – available from an Australia Post Office
<p>How will my application be assessed?</p>	<p>Your application will be assessed on the basis of either Centrelink payments (if that is your prime source of income) or you and your partner's (if you have one) total taxable income for the financial year ending June 2019.</p> <p>If you or your partner's circumstances have changed since last financial year, your application will be assessed based on current circumstances.</p>
<p>What terms and conditions need to be met for my application to be assessed?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You (and your partner) have provided the information requested • You (and your partner) meet the Income Test for the Scheme • You (and your partner) have read and signed the Declaration and Authorisation on Page 4 • Applications should be received prior to January 14, 2020 to enable processing prior to the start of the school year.
