St Peters Lutheran College Future Foundation offers the Rural Leadership Scholarship and provides opportunities for two Boarding students to benefit from a St Peters education, who may not have been able to do so without financial assistance.

This application for scholarship forms the first step in the application process. The application closing date is **Tuesday 31 July 2018**. Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed during Term 3, 2018 at St Peters Lutheran College Indooroopilly.

### Eligibility

To be eligible for the 2019 Rural Leadership Scholarship you need to be/have:

- A Year 10, Year 11 or Year 12 student in 2019;
- Australian citizen or permanent resident;
- 200 km or more away from St Peters Lutheran College, Indooroopilly;
- Exceptional leadership and academic, music, drama, visual art or sporting excellence;
- Willing to participate in a wide range of activities outside of the academic program, including leadership and service to others;
- Parents who are unable to consider St Peters for financial reasons; and
- Parents who are committed to cover any expenses over and above the scholarship amount of \$17,500 per annum.

The Rural Leadership Scholarship is means-tested. Parents of shortlisted students will be required to provide last year's tax return.
