It is Toorak College's hope that every visitor enjoys their stay at the College. In return for secure, clean and budget-priced accommodation and catering packages we also have a few expectations of our visitors to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable stay.

Our Expectations

Each guest is responsible for their own room and bedding. Cleaners will take care of common areas such as bathrooms, recreation rooms, etc however we would ask you to respect our surroundings by:

- Not littering.
- Not smoking.
- No alcohol is permitted in Joan Ansett Hall.
- No candles or oil burners in rooms.
- Respecting the rights and property of other attendees.
- Reporting any damage to Toorak College fit-tings or fixtures immediately.
- Cooking in any area of JAH is prohibited with-out the prior approval.

Access to other areas of JAH or the College not covered by your booking is not permitted.

Children

Children are to be supervised at all times for their own safety and are restricted to areas booked only. The pool area is definitely out of bounds without appropriate agreement and arrangements for its use with Toorak College.

Meals

Meals are generally served in the Dining Room or the Pavilion Café Terrace. Please attend promptly at meal times.

Site Security

The College's main gates will be locked at approximately 10.00 pm each night with external JAH doors being locked by your group's organizers, as agreed.

Access after these times should be pre-arranged with the College's onsite caretaker—the telephone number will be available from your group's organizers.

Telephones

Two pay telephones are located in Joan Ansett Hall - one in the main foyer and the other in the north wing. Please avail yourself of them. Visitors are not permitted to use non-paying phones which are for staff internal use only.

Clothes Washing & Drying

Two laundries are available for your use with washers and dryers in Joan Ansett Hall. Please use the laundry facilities that have been allocated for your group's use during your stay. A large drying room is also available.

Enjoying Yourself

- A safe swimming beach for adults & children alike is in walking distance—just head down Williams Road.
- A bus stop is located on Old Mornington Road—bus schedules are located on the noticeboard outside the common room.
