## School buses and Conveyance Allowance 2019

### Buses

This section contains information relating to School Chartered Buses operated by Driver Coastal, together with the following forms:

- (i) School Chartered Buses
- (ii) Bus Service Required
- (iii) Bus Routes and Timetable

You are encouraged to read all the information carefully and return any applicable forms to the School by the due date, Friday 1 February 2019.

### Conveyance Allowance 2019

To be eligible to claim the Conveyance Allowance in 2019, new applicants must meet the eligibility criteria as set out by the State Government.

- Eligibility Criteria 1 focuses on the age of your child(ren)
- Eligibility Criteria 2 focuses on the distance from your home to the nearest school of that type attended (Independent Non-Denominational). This must be more than 4.8kms.
- Eligibility Criteria 3 focuses on the mode of transport you may claim the conveyance allowance for:
  - Private car
  - Private bus
  - Public bus (PTV)

However, if you live within 4.8 km of a public bus or train route then you will ONLY be eligible to apply for the Public Bus (PTV) allowance and MUST provide proof of purchase of a Myki ticket to make this claim.

If you live within 4.8 km of a public bus or train route and choose to transport your child(ren) to school by car or private bus then you WILL NOT be eligible to claim the Conveyance Allowance.

## Conveyance Allowance - Eligibility Checklist

The below criteria is a guide to assist parents determine possible eligibility for the conveyance allowance. If you meet the below criteria the school recommends a claim be submitted. Final acceptance of the conveyance allowance is at the discretion of the Department of Education and Early Childhood Development. Meeting the criteria in the below guide does not guarantee acceptance of any conveyance allowance claim.

### Eligibility Criteria

#### Question 1

Is your child(ren) of school age?  
(5 to 18 years and attending Prep – Year 12)

- Yes - go to Question 2
- No - Not eligible to claim

#### Question 2

Does your child(ren) live more than 4.8 km by the shortest practicable route from Toorak College?

- Yes - go to Question 3
- No - Not eligible to claim

#### Question 3

Which form of transport does your child(ren) use to travel to school?

- PTV bus or train:  
(A copy of the receipt must be provided to the Business Office)
- Private bus
- Private car

The School lodges the claim for Conveyance Allowance at the beginning of March, therefore all forms must be returned to the School by Friday 22 February 2019. Approved allowances will be passed on to parents in the form of credits on the school fee account, when payment is received from the State Government.

The following forms relate to transportation arrangements for students to and from School in 2019.

### Chartered buses

- (i) Toorak College has contracted Driver Coastal to provide buses to and from Toorak College on the following routes:

- Sorrento – Rosebud
- Flinders – Red Hill – Mount Martha
- Shoreham – Balnarring – Somerville

Students require a Toorak College Student Identification Card. A student must validate the card on each occasion that they board or depart the bus. These travel records are used for charging purposes.

- (ii) Toorak College shares the following service with Peninsula Grammar.

- Patterson Lakes - Sandhurst - Langwarrin

This bus is contracted by Peninsula Grammar with the service being provided by Ventura.

The bus services mentioned in (i) and (ii) are charged to your school account at the end of each term. To use these services, **parents must complete the Bus Booking Form** and return by Friday 1 February to:

Bookings are made for the term and can be updated for permanent changes by submitting an updated Bus Booking Form. Cancellation of bus travel can be made by emailing [nataliek@toorak.vic.edu.au](mailto:nataliek@toorak.vic.edu.au). The cancellation date will be the date the email is received.

### Casual use

Students may use the above services on a casual basis. Each trip is charged per occasion at the casual rate applicable to that journey. Students require a Toorak College Student Identification Card. A student must validate the card on each occasion that they board or depart the bus. These travel records are used for charging purposes.

### Public buses

All other buses to and from the School are PTV Buses. These buses require the student to have a Myki ticket and are not controlled by the School. Timetables have been provided by Public Transport Victoria and are advised as estimated times only.
