



## UNIFORM POLICY

1. The normal College uniform consists of grey shirt and College tie, grey suit trousers, and grey/black socks (or grey dress shorts and long College socks), black belt and black leather dress shoes. Year 12 students wear a long sleeved white shirt instead of a grey shirt. All students are to wear the College Akubra style hat to and from the College, College Assemblies and at College functions. During the 2nd and 3rd Terms the College blazer is also to be worn (for Year 11 and 12 students, red blazers and grey long trousers are to be worn). The College pullover may also be worn during winter. Those who have met the criteria and have the approval of the Principal may wear honour pockets. For formal occasions, blazer, a white shirt and long trousers are to be worn.
2. The uniform for Physical Education consists of house polo, black shorts, hat, or cap, socks and sand shoes or as otherwise directed by the Physical Education teacher.
3. Correct Terrace sporting uniform is to be worn when representing the College.
4. Students who are **spectating at GPS sport** during the winter season, Rugby or Football, or at any major GPS carnival (Swimming, Cross Country, Athletics), are required to wear their school uniform, even if they have played on that particular day. At other times of the year when students have played on the day they may wear their team sports uniform. **Covered footwear** must be worn at all times.
5. House polos are to be worn for all House events and PE classes, and at other times during the school year as directed.
6. Apart from students at the Boatshed and by Poolside, **thongs** or **scuffs** are not acceptable at any time.
7. Students who train at the College after school may travel home in the correct sports uniform including **covered footwear**.

## PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Students should appear presentable at all times. The uniform should be clean, pressed, complete and shoes polished.

### Dress

To maintain a high standard of dress, the following specific regulations must be adhered to:

1. Uniform must be worn appropriately at all times:
  - Socks up
  - Shirts tucked in
  - Black belt
  - Black leather shoes (cleaned and polished)
  - Top button of shirt done up when wearing a tie.
  - Black socks with long trousers.
  - College akubra
  - Shorts / Trousers to be worn on the waistline.
  - Clothes to be pressed / ironed.
2. Students must maintain a high standard of personal hygiene.
3. Jewellery is not to be worn with the uniform:
  - No earrings
  - No studs: no body piercing (ie nose, eyebrows and tongue)
  - No chains, wrist chains
  - No ringsA crucifix may be worn on a chain around the neck.
