

## 2019 Fees Schedule for Australian Students

The following fees and conditions apply to Australian Resident students.

### Pre-Commencement Fees

These fees are payable upon registration and when a place of enrolment is offered.

### College Fees

Fees at the College include all subject costs for core curriculum activities, text books, standard camps, excursions which form part of the curriculum, participation in all TAS and Junior TAS sports and participation in the Performing Arts. Additional charges will be levied for any optional camps, musical instrument hire and other items listed under Other Charges.

## Other Charges

The following charges may also be incurred:

- Lost or Damaged Text Books and Library Books must be replaced and will be charged at their replacement value.
- Non-Compulsory Curriculum Activities costs will be borne by the parents (for example: Year 12 Formal, Year 11 Semi Formal, Year 12 Jerseys) in addition to the scheduled fees.
- Non-Compulsory Excursions undertaken by some Departments after College hours (primarily English, Drama and Music) will be managed by the relevant teacher organising the excursion. They will advise of the charges and these must be paid to the College Cashier's Office for all students attending, prior to departure.
- Stationery requirements are recommended to be purchased separately through the Book Pack system managed by the Parents and Friends Association.
- Other Charges which may include Musical Instrument Hire and /or any other sundry charges, are billed periodically throughout the year and must be paid by the due date as shown on the Statement of Account.
- Music Instrumental Tuition charges will be billed directly by the Instrument Teacher.
