

## 2019 Study Abroad Program

The Study Abroad program is an excellent opportunity for International students to improve their English and experience Australian culture by studying in one of Queensland's leading private schools.

### Who should apply for this program?

Students who are travelling to Australia, on a visitor/tourist visa and wish to study in an English program and experience school life in mainstream classes. Entry to mainstream classes, and the number of subjects that can be studied, is dependent on the student's English language ability. Programs commence at the beginning of each academic term: 30 January, 23 April, 16 July and 8 October, 2019. **Entry Requirements:** Applicants must be studying in Junior High School or Senior High School in their own country, must be passing the majority of their course and have good grades for conduct.

**Course Duration:** Term 1 – 10 weeks; Term 2 – 9 weeks; Term 3 – 10 weeks; Term 4 – 9 weeks

### Accommodation:

Students will live with a host family approved and arranged by West Moreton Anglican College. Alternatively, students may live with their parents or a guardian as defined by the Department of Immigration.

### Application Process:

Please submit: -WestMAC application form; - Most recent academic report; - Copy of passport bio page. Documents are to be faxed or emailed to [ashaw@wmac.com.au](mailto:ashaw@wmac.com.au) six (6) weeks prior to commencement.

The application will be assessed and an offer made within two (2) working days. Acceptance of the offer and full payment is required four (4) weeks prior to arrival. When payment has been received you will be asked to complete a homestay application and arrival form. Students will complete an English placement test on arrival.

### Homestay and Student Services:

West Moreton Anglican College arranges accommodation with a host family approved by the College. Included are:

- 3 meals a day and snacks (breakfast, lunch and dinner)
- Weekly laundry service.
- Single room
- All family members over 18 will have a current blue card (Police check)
- 24 hour emergency support
- Full time homestay officer
- Airport pickup on arrival and departure

Personal wi-fi data and 9 or 10 week bus ticket are available at an additional cost. Each student will be issued with a certificate of attendance.
