Examining the perspective of particular groups of POW's ... army nurses captured in Singapore .
AC9HH10K03	Significant events and turning points of WWII ...	Explaining why particular events were significant turning points in the Asia-Pacific theatre of war ... the fall of Singapore in 1942...
ACHH10K04	The effects of WWII with a particular emphasis on the continuities and changes on the Australian home front, such as the changing roles of women and First Nations Australians and the use of wartime government controls.	Investigating the effects of WWII on the changing roles of women in Australia during the war (for example, women in the military , the Women's Land Army, factory work) contrasted with their continuities of their roles before and after the war .
