Thank you for your request of 29 May regarding your constituent, Ms Jennifer Macleod and her request for a pedestrian refuge in Dewar Terrace at the intersection with Marlborough Street.

The request has been investigated and I can advise that while considering a location for a pedestrian facility, Council's primary focus is for the safety of pedestrians while maintaining efficient traffic movement

on the road network. I appreciate that pedestrians on some occasions would be delayed in crossing Dewar Terrace, however, in general, there are sufficient gaps in traffic for pedestrians to cross with minimal delay.

Council will be conducting a pedestrian count across Dewar Terrace (Near the intersection of Dewar terrace and Marlborough Street) to assess the need for a pedestrian crossing facility and based on the results it will be listed for future funding in line with city wide priorities.

A search of official traffic crash records has also been undertaken and this has not identified any significant safety issues at this location at present.
