The Derwent Valley Railway (DVR) is a not for profit incorporated association committed to the preservation and utilisation of historic railways. The DVR Depot is located at New Norfolk in the Derwent Valley, 35 kilometers north-west of Hobart.

The DVR owns a number of steam and diesel locomotives previously used for mainline running on the Tasmanian rail network. The DVR also has passenger cars from the prime Tasmanian passenger service - the Tasman Limited - in addition to a variety of goods wagons.

It is intended to resume passenger excursions, on the Main and Derwent Valley Lines.

All work, including maintenance, restoration and train running, is carried out by volunteers. As such your membership is valuable to cover administrative costs. No other participation is required, although any skills you may have would be useful and appreciated.
