## **Kelcey Tier Greenbelt**

Kelcey Tier Greenbelt is a precious bushland reserve located in Stony Rise, approximately 4.5 kilometres south of Devonport's CBD, consisting of 160 hectares of native bushland dominated by stringy bark (Eucalyptus obliqua) and Eucalyptus ovata (swamp gum). The native fauna that can be sited include the eastern barred bandicoot (vulnerable species), swift parrot (endangered species) and Bennett's Wallaby.

Access is available via Durkins Road, off Stony Rise Road, Stony Rise.

## **Facilities**

"Preeatenna" Lizard Sculpture

("Preeatenna" means "lizard" in the Tasmanian Aboriginal language, reinforcing the important Aboriginal cultural links to the area).

- Preeatenna Lookout
- Several unformed tracks
- Designated gravel parking area off Durkins Road
- \*\*closest public toilet at Mersey Vale cemetery, Stony Rise Rd

## Things to see and do

- Walking
- View the Lizard Sculpture at the lookout
- View the Peace Pole
- Admire the bush
- View the wildflowers during Spring/Summer
- View the fungi growth during Autumn/Winter



Follow the orange track markers from Durkins Road car park.

## Kelcey Tier Circuit Walk

The circuit walk takes in the Peace Pole Walk and Allison Track Walk and includes a far more extensive opportunity to

walk through and see the native flora and fauna that exists within the Greenbelt.

- Distance: 3.6 km
- Walking Time: 1.5 to 2 hours (approximate time for casual pace walk)
- Walk Grade: moderate

### Allison Track Walk

Once you enter the Greenbelt from Durkins Road car park follow the KT1 track markers to the Lookout and Lizard Sculpture and return on the same path.

- Distance: 1.4 km return
- Walking Time: 24 minutes return (approximate time for casual pace walk)
- Walk Grade: easy

### Peace Pole Walk

Once you enter the Greenbelt from Durkins Road car park follow the peace pole signs to the Peace Pole and return on the same path.

- Distance: 1.2 km return
- Walking Time: 20 minutes return (approximate time for casual pace walk)
- Walk Grade: relatively easy
