

## Greyhound Hour - Educational Checklist



- All participants must present the greyhounds' muzzle exemption card when entering the premises
- We recommend that greyhounds are initially muzzled, owners should allow greyhounds off leash and unmuzzled at their own risk
- We recommend that if the dog is unsure, more timid and shy, owners should take their greyhound into the dog park initially leashed and only allow them off leash once they are certain the dog will do well in the unleashed environment
- If dogs are showing signs of nervousness, we recommend the owner should leash their dog and try the smaller enclosure for a more secure opportunity to try the park. Please see attached dog body language document when talking about fear or nervousness in dogs
- Owners should bring water supply and poo bags for their dogs
- The organisers of this event cannot be held responsible for any injuries, infections etc. all attendees to the dog park acknowledge they are bringing their dogs at their own risk
- Greyhound event not recommended for foster dogs, the event is focussed on greyhounds that have been assessed and suitable for the muzzle exemption
- If owners are not paying attention to the rules and recommendations they may be asked to leave the event.
