

CHAIR'S SUMMARY

The third meeting of the Kagaru to Acacia Ridge and Bromelton (K2ARB) Community Consultative Committee was held in Algester on Tuesday, 14 May 2019.

This summary provides an overview of the committee meeting and ensures that information is shared with the community at the earliest opportunity. It is a precursor to the formal meeting record, the committee meeting minutes, which will be published on the Inland Rail website following preparation and endorsement by the committee and Chair.

The meeting was chaired by Mr John Brent and attended by 14 of the 15 local community representatives appointed as members of the committee. More than 100 observers attended the meeting.

The main purpose of the meeting was to provide a project update and general information regarding noise and vibration investigations and requirements.

Presentations were provided by members of the ARTC K2ARB project team. The Chair of Inland Rail's Scenic Rim Community Consultative Committee was also a guest speaker at the K2ARB CCC.

Information provided to the committee included:

- ▶ A progress update on the project, including information regarding environmental investigations to be undertaken.
- ▶ Details about the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) process, should the project be declared a "coordinated project".
- ▶ Information about consultation with the local community.

Committee members requested the following actions during the meeting:

- ▶ ARTC to include on the next meeting agenda, a discussion regarding opportunity for the committee to request independent technical advice.

- ▶ ARTC to respond to questions tabled by a Member, prior to the next meeting.
- ▶ ARTC to amend references to the two proposed new crossing loops in the project area to a geographical reference to prevent confusion regarding their location.

The following actions are ongoing:

- ▶ The provision of maps of the locations where environmental investigations will take place, once known.
- ▶ Notification to the community as to the outcome of the request to the Office of the Coordinator General on the project approval pathway.

The next meeting will be held on 5 August. Details will be shared closer to the date to ensure those who would like to attend have that opportunity.
