BACKGROUND

The Revised Delivery Program 2017-2021 and Operational Plan 2018-2019 outlines actions and strategies Council will undertake to achieve the objectives defined in the Lake Macquarie City Community Strategic Plan 2017-2027. Council's Operational Plan 2018-2019 and Fees and Charges 2018-2019 will guide a schedule of works for the next financial year.






WE ASKED

During April and May 2018, we asked the community to provide their feedback on the Revised Draft Delivery Program 2017-2021, Operational Plan 2018-2019 and Draft Fees and Charges 2018-2019.







WHO PARTICIPATED?

More than 3500 people were actively engaged, by viewing information online, providing feedback or participating in face-to-face discussions.

HOW DID WE REACH YOU?

-  1700+ visits to Shape Lake Mac project page with eight submissions received
-  1400+ visits to the interactive 2018-2019 works map including 32 comments and 152 likes on projects
-  300+ people engaged with us via social media (likes, comments, shares, and click throughs) with more than 35,800 reached
-  100+ people participated in Lake Mac chats held at Swansea Visitor Centre, Lake Macquarie City Farmers Markets and Toronto Lions Club Markets

-  Complete construction of Munibung Road extension linking Boolaroo and Cardiff
-  Replace existing playground and equipment at Kahibah Park
-  Continue construction of Warners Bay Foreshore upgrade
-  New section of shared pathway between Speers Point and Glendale
-  Internal refurbishment of Rathmines Community Hall
-  800m of footpath from Swansea High School to Northcote Avenue.
