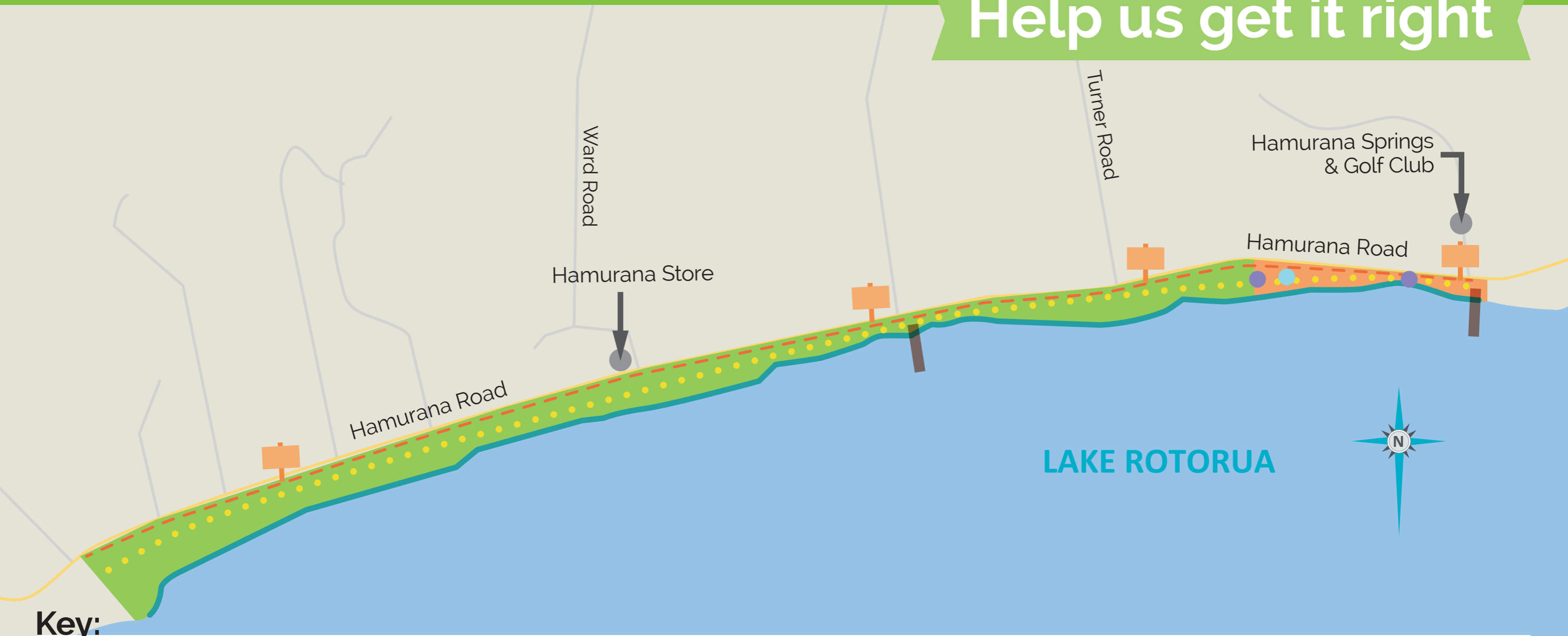


HAMURANA RESERVE DEVELOPMENT

Help us get it right



Key:

— Foreshore protection

Physical works to stabilise lake edge erosion and stop any further encroachment of the lake into the reserve.

••• Formed pathway (indicative)

Permanent all weather surface, 2.5 metre wide, shared use, with footbridges. Pathway spans the length of the reserve.

- - - Restrict vehicle access & define carparking

Either bollards or fencing along all or defined areas of the reserve roadside frontage, restricting vehicle access. Off-road parking, designated from carparks.

■ Natural character & maintenance

Retain the current natural undeveloped state of the reserve with further planting enhancement.

■ Overnight camping area

A designated area for overnight campers.

■ Interpretive signage

Signage depicting points of interest, cultural significance and history of the land.

■ Boat ramp development

Upgrade of both the existing boat ramps/jetty's and associated parking areas.

● Playground development

Development/ upgrade of the existing playground in its current location.

● Toilet refurbishment

Upgrade of existing toilet blocks in current locations.
