What does your business do and what is your involvement in the stadium project?

NambuCCA Plumbing provides a reliable and professional commercial plumbing service to Coffs Harbour and the mid north coast region, employing 24 team members that work and live locally.

Our involvement in the stadium project includes the hydraulic design (with Glen Haig & Partners from Sawtell) and installation which includes: water, sewer, storm water, and water treatment.

When will we see you/your team onsite, and how many people will you have working on the project?

In March our team will commence the temporary connection of site offices and amenities and the main build of the southern grandstand at which point we could have up to eight or more local tradesmen and apprentices working at once.

More than half of our plumbers are Coffs locals – so we consider ourselves a very local business!

We sponsor the Coffs Harbour Football and OzTag team.
