

## PLANNING SYSTEM GUIDING PRINCIPLES

## As adopted Council 25 July 2017

The SA Government are creating a new planning system. The City of Adelaide considers the planning system should achieve, and be measured against, the following guiding principles:



A planning system should be based on the following guiding principles:

- 1. A visionary approach that informs long-term strategies and policies;
- 2. Effective community engagement is underpinned by a robust charter and fostering of partnerships;
- 3. **Continuity** is enhanced by building on strengths of past systems.
- 4. **Local autonomy is balanced with support for broader interests** recognising that local determination can affect regional and State interest and fostering local ownership is key for great places;



- 5. High quality design is promoted;
- 6. Transparency, accessibility, accountability and integrity underpin decisions and systems;
- 7. The system is founded on **equity**;
- 8. **Efficiency, effectiveness and economy** are fostered by decisions at the lowest competent level and least necessary administration;
- 9. **Integration and coordination** are achieved through well prepared strategies informing clear rules which enable integrated outcomes;
- 10. **Certainty** is achieved through clarity regarding the conditions under which development can proceed and the way principles and mechanisms will apply;
- 11. The system is **responsive** to changing circumstances through flexibility and evaluation of trends and performance.

Note: These City of Adelaide Planning System Guiding Principles are aligned with the Objectives and principles of good planning contained in the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure* Act 2016.
