

CITY WORKS PERMIT APPLICATION

Partial road closure in Waymouth Street on 18 August 2018

Consultation closes **5:00pm, Wednesday 8 August, 2018**

PROJECT INFORMATION

The City of Adelaide (CoA) would like your feedback on an application for a City Works Permit submitted by Cesar Federici for construction work at the BankSA building, 97 King William Street that will require the closure of:

- Waymouth Street between King William St and Anster Road, and
- Waymouth Place, Hall Court and Cordwainers Lane from 6am and 6pm on 18 August 2018.

Background

Under Division 6 (Control of Work on Roads), Section 223 of *The Local Government Act (SA)1999*, CoA has a legislative requirement to consult the public when an application for a City Works Permit received thus:

223—Public consultation

(1) If a council proposes to grant an authorisation or permit—

(a) that would result in any part of a road being fenced, enclosed or partitioned so as to impede the passage of traffic to a material degree; or

(c) in relation to a use or activity for which public consultation is required under the regulations, the council must, before granting the authorisation or permit, follow the relevant steps set out in its public consultation policy.

(2) The council must also give written notice of the proposal to agencies that are, under the regulations, to be notified of the proposal. (3) The regulations may prescribe exceptions to the operation of subsection (1)(a).

CoA's public consultation policy (<https://www.cityofadelaide.com.au/assets/Policies-Papers/docs/POLICY-public-communication-consultation.pdf>) states that to comply with Section 223 (see page 9, column 14) we are required to:

- Provide public notice of the City Works Permit application received
- Provide a 'consultation period' of 21 days for people to provide feedback on the application
- During the consultation period, make the permit application available for public viewing in our customer centre, community centres and libraries, and
- Publish a notice in a locally circulating newspaper (in this instance the 'Messenger'); and on a designated website. In this instance the designated website is CoA's online community engagement platform, *Your Say Adelaide* (<https://yoursay.cityofadelaide.com.au>)
- Provide you with means to provide your feedback on the permit application during the 21-day's consultation period (see **How Do I Provide My Feedback** below), and
- Ensure that all feedback is considered as part of the assessment process, and
- Inform the public of the outcome
