# Dunn Street Carpark

## Proposed Licence over one (1) carpark space for telecommunication infrastructure

Consultation closes **5:00pm, Wednesday 6 March 2019**

### Purpose

We are seeking your feedback on granting a long-term licence to TPG Network Pty Ltd (TPG) over one (1) carpark space of Dunn Street Carpark for the installation of telecommunication equipment to support the Ten Gigabit Adelaide project.

### Project Background and Information

At its meeting of 5 December 2017 Council endorsed the *Ten Gigabit Adelaide* project.

The Ten Gigabit Adelaide project is a revolutionary high-speed, high-performance fibre optic data network that is being rolled out to 1,000 commercial businesses in the CBD and North Adelaide.

To support the roll-out of Ten Gigabit Adelaide, Council is examining the feasibility of granting a long-term licence to TPG of one (1) carpark space in Dunn Street Carpark (Fig.1) for telecommunication equipment. The telecommunication network equipment (Point of Presence) will support the connection of local businesses to the Ten Gigabit Adelaide network.

TPG intends to install telecommunication network equipment (Point of Presence) hosted inside a cabinet (Fig.2). The proposed location is the first carpark space on the left entering from the southern entrance to Dunn Street Carpark and will be screened by the existing plants (Fig.3).

The proposed lease area is a portion (one carpark) of Dunn Street Carpark, Allotment 82 contained in Certificate of Title Volume 5128 Folio 277.

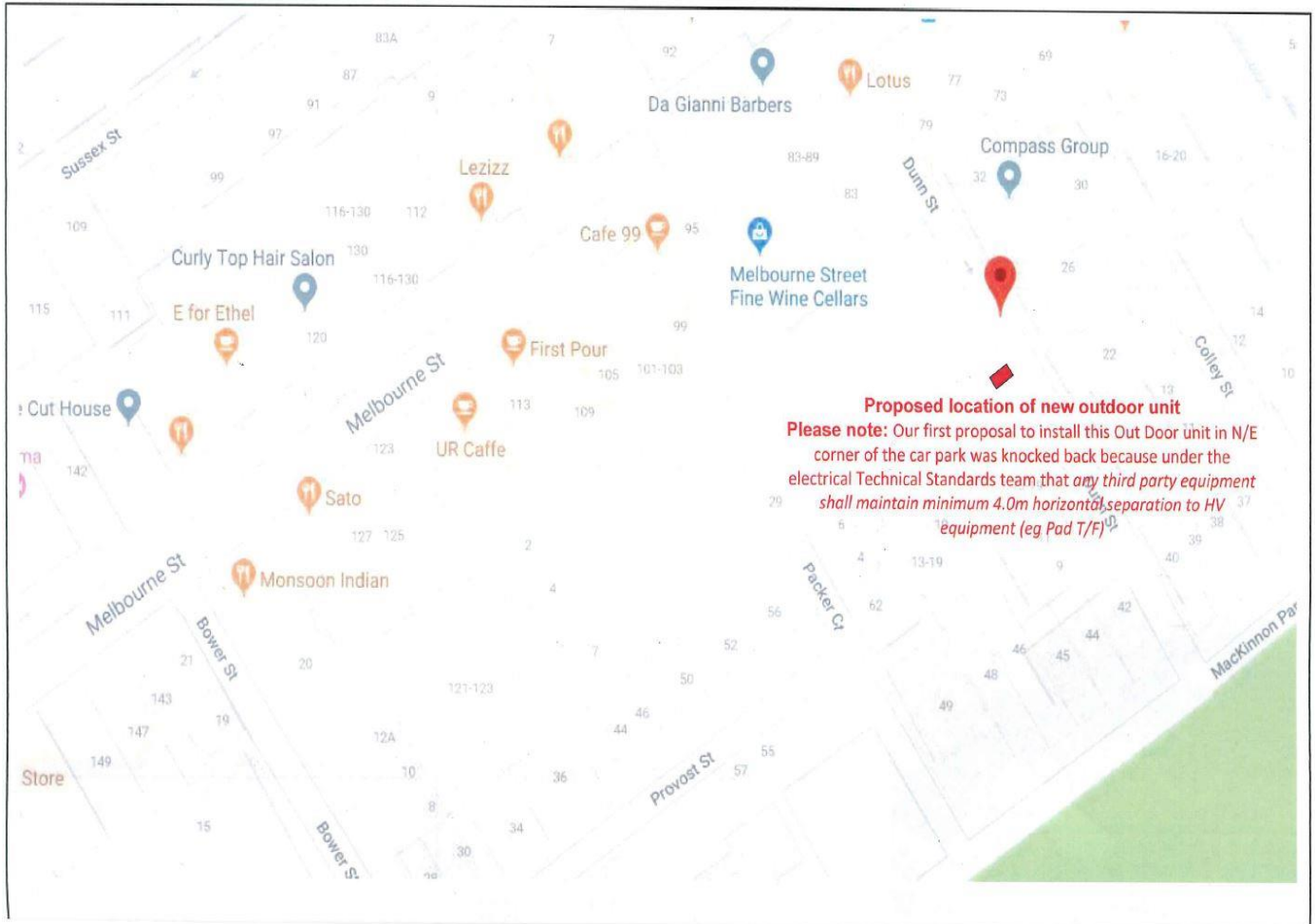

Fig.1 Location of Dunn Street Car Park

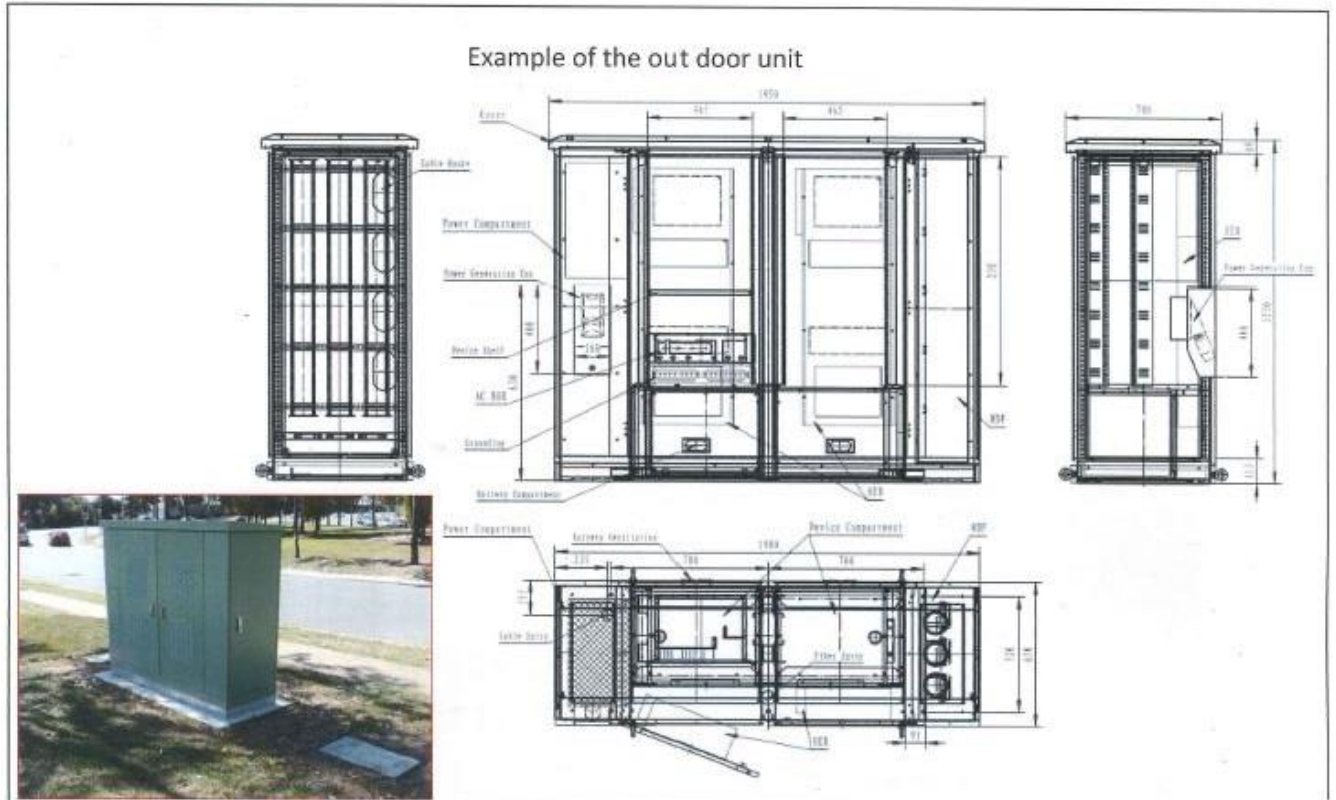
