We will spend this term rehearsing and filming a short film: *The Search for the Selfish Elf* (working title). Thanks to Creative Communities funding there is no extra cost to Brickworks families for participating in this project.

Preparation

We have already started planning and dreaming up the look of the film with the students who enrolled in our Term Two Zoom drama classes. If you weren't enrolled for Term Two it's no problem. We are now writing the script and all Term Three students will have plenty to do!

Available online

When it's finished, the film will be available to view via our Facebook and website pages (using Vimeo or YouTube as a platform). This means you will need to be comfortable with your child being part of a film that is made publicly available. (If you would prefer not to use your child's name in the credits, you can let us know.) We will create a permission form, especially for the film.

Time Commitment

There will be rehearsals, costume fittings, and shoot dates that take place outside of regular class hours - an extra time commitment of approx. 10 hours per child. As always we will do our best to accommodate your needs and schedules but will require your commitment to this increased schedule (especially on shoot dates).

We aim to have the film finished and ready to present back to the Brickworks whanau at the end of Term Four with a special "premiere" at The Chapel. Tickets will be a sale at a family-friendly price.
