How?

Outcome 1: Strong sense of identity

- We maintain high expectations and understand children's physical capabilities
- We provide an opportunity for children to engage with us independently
- Instructors encourage children to 'have a go' especially when an activity seems initially challenging
- We ensure kids celebrate their achievements and the achievements of others
- We promote group experience and play
- Our class consists of a predictable and effective routine.
- Our small class size allows for positive interactions with each child

Outcome 2: Connection & contribution to the world

- We encourage children to show sportsmanship, showing them how take turns, share equipment and work with other children in the class
- Children feel part of a team and develop an understanding of fairness and how everyone's ability is recognized.

Outcome 3: Strong Sense of Wellbeing

- We show respect for all children
- We ensure all children experience pride in their attempts and achievements
- We support and enhance the development of gross motor skills
- Our activities involve energetic physical activity
- Children have the opportunity to work collaboratively with others to be a part of the team.

Outcome 4: Confident and Involved Learners

- We encourage children to learn and grow
- We provide new experiences for children to engage in activities they may not have been exposed to before such as balancing beams, dice, small and large balls, different bats, tug of war rope etc

- We respond to children's efforts to communicate
- We sing and chant numbers and sing songs
