

TimberNook Birthday Parties

Imagine the woods come alive with cheer and magic. Inviting décor cascades off of the trees. Children may experience a full-blown mud run challenge or design their own tea party experience. Later, the children get to cook over an open fire and play the TimberNook way out in the woods. We offer a variety of unique experiences for children ages 18 mths to 12 years of age. Designed to inspire creativity and ignite the senses, these parties are sure to excite, challenge, and delight.

I'm very excited to introduce to you TimberNook Birthday Parties. TimberNook birthday parties are another way to get children outdoors and playing in nature, testing their creativity and using their imagination. The sky is the limit to what we can create for these special events. Choose from one of our popular outdoor experiences or tailor your very own!

A birthday event begins with a safety briefing and fun icebreakers, children then delight in a unique TimberNook experience, followed by cooking a snack on the campfire and free play. In the closing 30 minutes we bring the children together to sing Happy Birthday, cut the cake and open any gifts.

Our parties are priced at \$30 per child with a minimum of 8. There is no charge for accompanying adults or infants under 18mths. Included in this cost is 2 1/2 hour event hire, trained staff to run your party, food to cook on the campfire for all children (sausages, popcorn and marshmallows are favourites), postcard invitations and all play supplies and activities. We make time for the birthday child to open gifts, blow out candles and share birthday cake (not supplied) with their friends.

What you need to know:

Ask party guests to wear shoes and clothes for outdoor play and to bring along a warm jacket. A spare change of clothes is also a good idea!

Parties are held at our woolshed classroom located at the end of Stratton Street, Normandale in Belmont Regional Park. Children enjoy our outdoor environment and we also have a large heated indoor space should the weather be poor. We will venture outside! You are most welcome to bring along additional food (note this is not necessary as the children will be busily engaged in play) and of course **birthday cake**. We have coffee and tea facilities and filtered water onsite (bring fresh milk). Plates, cups, and cutlery are available for guest use. We also provide towels and blankets if needed. An emergency 1st aid kit and spare sunscreen and bug spray are kept on site. Note: there is no mobile phone reception. In the event of an emergency phone reception is only a short walk away.

Outdoor Experiences

Animal Shelter

The children will have the opportunity to “adopt” an animal in the woods today and take care of them. We create a simple play scene in the woods that invites children to play “animal shelter.”

Blast Off

Get ready for high energy to fill the air as children are moving and bustling about trying out all of the space stations.

Gnome Village

Small but mighty, the gnomes of TimberNook come to life and share their innately curious personalities leading to some great ingenious play.

Nature Fairies (most popular)

Want to see a sparkle in a child’s eyes? Just watch their expressions when they take on the persona of a fairy and express their attributions and admiration to their surroundings. Think bigger than the traditional “fairy” image and move into a realm of fairies that withhold powers of water, leaves, sun...behold the land of Nature Fairies!

Never Grow Up Party

Children celebrate in Peter Pan style by partaking in a Never Grow Up Party. They arrive in pajamas and enjoy food, games, and festivities.

Night Villagers (a favourite with older children)

Children will have the opportunity to create an entire village of hideouts in the woods. Come and join a glowing evening of play in the forest, cooking dinner over an open fire, and more!

Nighttime Warrior Camp

A game of glowing adventure in the woods where nighttime thieves must try and steal the glowing jewels from the nighttime warriors.

Pots, Pans, and Cans (top pick for pre-schoolers)

A very simple idea that holds the key to rich and creative play. We plant the seed for playing music on pots and pans but this party takes on many other directions by adding some loose parts.

Sail Away (a fabulous summer theme)

Designing and creating boats to sail can be as much fun as actually sailing them. Children delight in this day on the water as they tap into their creativity and engineering ingenuity to create and race their very own boats down the stream.

Super Heroes (a delight for ages 4 – 7 yrs)

Get ready to watch your group save the day as they maneuver through the bush saving stuffed animals along the way.

Tea Party (top event anytime of day)

What could be more enchanting than a tea party in the woods. Design your very own tea cups and create a magical tea party setting. Or move this traditional play theme from day to night to mesmerise the senses. We light up the bush with twinkling LED latterns for a magical evening of fun outdoors!

The Great Treasure Hunt (for the adventurous child)

The children will work together as a group reading and following rhyming clues, ultimately leading to the treasure. We traverse through different types of environments, such as climbing over boulders, going through mud puddles, digging up clues... what will you uncover?
