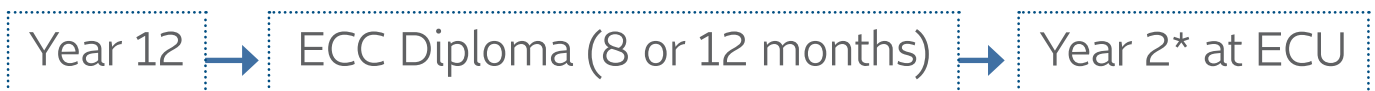




# Unlock your potential
