In NYFA AU's one-year screenwriting program, students undergo a transformative process, exploring unexamined nuances of everyday life or flights of imagination to other worlds. Our programs nurture students and their work in a collaborative, hands-on, intensive environment, giving them the tools to write, workshop and film original stories in a variety of formats and genres.

NYFA AU screenwriting students learn first-hand from prolific industry professionals who offer constructive feedback in an intimate workshop setting, allowing students to hone their craft and



create their best original work. Students gain visual storytelling knowledge, technical skills, and comprehensive project-based experiences. An emphasis on creating professional-calibre material allows screenwriting students to graduate with a body of work of which they can be proud.

The program uses Autodesk's Oscar-winning software, Maya — the industry standard for animation — as well as a suite of other professional supporting applications, including ZBrush and the full Adobe Creative Cloud. Led by a world-class faculty of working 3D animators, students create original work and gain professional-level skills that help them compete as independent animators, or in the film, gaming, interactivity, and commercial industries. Learn the technical and artistic tools you need to achieve mastery in the craft of 3D modelling, animation and visual effects.

Southport is the leading educational and creative arts precinct of the Gold Coast, easily accessible by public transport and full of amenities (libraries, shopping centers, cafes and restaurants). NYFA AU Gold Coast also maintains its own production studios on-site at the renowned Village Roadshow Studios, giving students the opportunity to do their production work in the backlot. Village Roadshow Studios has been the filming location of many Hollywood films including *San Andreas*, *Unbraken*, *Pirates of the Caribbean: Dead Men Tell No Tales*, *The Shallow*, *Kong: Skull Island*, and *Thor: Ragnarok*, among others.

Golden beaches, tropical rainforests, rugged country and a modern city skyline are just some of the backdrops that keep the biggest filmmakers in the world coming back to the Gold Coast. With an average of 300 days of sunshine every year, this region is commonly known as "beautiful one day, perfect the next," and as a surfer's paradise.
