Lady Jane Franklin Heritage Park Project	Franklin Cider Company	Project to restore the former St John's heritage church and cemetery adjacent to Frank's Cider House and Café, including the repair and restoration of colonial headstones and the installation of a self-guided interpretative trail through the church grounds and cemetery highlighting indigenous and colonial heritage. The project will deliver a new visitor attraction as well as provide a space for community activities and events.
Event Self Sufficiency	Far South Tasmania	Project to acquire a pool of equipment to support local community groups to run public events, including a series of "Far South Feasts" to be held in Southport and Dover to coincide with Mona's Darklab Project X.
The Big Tree lives on through augmented reality	Huon Valley Council	Project to create a life-sized augmented reality replica of the Arve Giant, previously one of the world's tallest trees, which was lost in the bushfire event.
Bushfire Preparedness	Maydena Community Association	Project to deliver Bushfire Ready Neighbourhood training in conjunction with Tasmania Fire Service, and purchase resources to assist community communications in the event of a future natural disaster.
Dover Township Entrance and Tourist Information Upgrade	Huon Valley Council	Project to enhance the entrance area to Dover township to increase the appeal of Dover as the gateway to the Far South, and to encourage tourists/visitors to stop in the area.
Savour – Huonville Wineries	Kate Hill Wines	A joint venture marketing campaign to be delivered by Kate Hill Wines and Home Hill Wines including targeted print marketing to interstate visitors via strategic points of entry highlighting local food and beverage businesses, and social media marketing to local Tasmanians and visitors highlighting events and other points of interest in the region.
Equipment Enhancements for State Emergency Services	West Coast Council	Project to provide additional shelter, lighting, equipment and signage for use in the event of a natural disaster.

The Wooden Boat Centre Profile Upgrade	The Wooden Boat Centre Franklin	Project to upgrade the Centre's facilities and promote visitor attractions/experiences which aims to increase visitation to both the Wooden Boat Centre and the Huon Valley area.
Fire Protection Improvement - Trial Harbour	Trial Harbour Progress Association Inc	Project to improve current firebreak located on the eastern flank of Trial Harbour to a standard that can be maintained by the Association.
Tools to Produce	Railtrack Riders Pty Ltd	Project to purchase equipment which will assist the business to: expand current employment and Work for the Dole opportunities (tourism and fabrication); repair and add to its current asset base; and expand operations to include the manufacture of speciality components for export to identified markets.
Bronte Park Community 'Get Together' Meeting, Picnic, Family Area	Central Highlands Council	Project to develop a community meeting space incorporating toilets, community noticeboard, barbeque, seating and shelter.
Accessible Community Amenities	Derwent Valley Council	Project to install disability access and accessible bathroom facilities in the New Norfolk Sports Centre which will allow the Council to use the building as an evacuation centre in the case of a natural disaster. The project will also improve the amenity of the building for community members with a disability who would like to participate in sport and recreation activities offered at the Centre by the New Norfolk PCYC.
Pagan Cider Cidery (Stage 2)	Pagan Produce Pty Ltd (T/as Pagan Cider)	Project to purchase equipment to extend current processing abilities, which will allow the business to undertake processing that is currently outsourced interstate.
Sport and Recreation Precinct	Maydena Community Association	Project to transform the previous Maydena pool site into a community recreation hub.
Rediscover Geeveston's Heritage	Geeveston Archives and History Society (GAHS)	Project to produce a printed DL brochure to promote the organisation's activities and two historical self-guided walking maps which will highlight sites of historical significance in the Geeveston township and encourage visitors to spend more time in the local area.
Golf Club Greens Recovery	Rosebery Golf Club	Project to install signage to promote the Club's overnight camping and recreation vehicle facilities and purchase irrigation equipment which will assist the Club to maintain its greens.
