THREADS FILMING GUIDELINES 15 Aug 2012

EQUIPMENT:

- 1. Video camera/dslr
- 2. Tripod
- 3. 3-4 lights in case
- 4. White Backdrop sheet

PREPARATION:

- 1. All batteries on charge: Camera, microphone receiver.
- 2. Give document explaining purpose of Threads to participants. (See document)
- 3. Explain the purpose and content of the Thread (testimony) to participants.

Start by saying "My name is John Smith . . . etc

 a. Background and upbringing: 3 minutes
 b. Experiences in life – BEFORE meeting Jesus 2 minutes
 c. The change that happened when met Jesus 1 minute
 d. Life AFTER meeting Jesus 3 minute. Finish by saying 'my name is John Smith, and that's my thread."


DUE DILIGENCE:

1. Explain RELEASE DOCUMENT and get participants to sign. (See sample on website). Copy must be sent to Hope office, ID with PN and hard copy saved in file.

SETUP:

- 1. White background: Eg White sheet on a frame.
- 2. A chair or stool to sit on (no arm rests or back rest if possible)
- 3. Set up tripod. Camera face level, level the tripod / camera.
- 4. Face camera AWAY from the noise source. (Choose as quiet a place if possible)
- 5. Lighting setup: (Use all same white color globes)
 - a. Light up the white background even spread of light. (Light 1)
 - b. Light up the back of presenter (Light 2).
 - c. Light up the face of the presenter (Light 3).
 - d. Light up the face of the presenter (Light 4).

CAMERA SETUP (Sony EX1)

- 1. Set up the tripod.
- 2. Slide Camera onto tripod, in forward position then lock with yellow lever.
- 3. Set camera lens level with subject's face.
- 4. Level the tripod/ camera.
- 5. Lift steering arm up and lock into place.
- 6. Check that charged battery is installed. (Press button to see full ight)
- 7. Open Lens cover.
- 8. Set up LCD monitor.
- 9. Turn cameras ON: Press green and to right.
- 10. FRAME the subject.
 - a. Top of head near top of frame, over shoulders on bottom frame.
 - b. Zoom in till eyes in between middle and top.
 - c. Subject off-centre to right.
- 11. FOCUS:
 - a. Zoom in focus on eyebrows.
 - b. Expanded focus then sharp focus on eyebrows.
- 12. Check glare in glasses. If glare, shift lights 3 and 4 up higher and point down more.

AUDIO SET UP:

- 1. Microphone, transmitter, receiver, cable and batteries are in the camera case.
- 2. Attach mike to transmitter. Attach cable to receiver.
- 3. Slide the receiver onto camera hot shoe, and plug cable into camera plug.
- 4. Mike up the subject: Mike facing down, cable hidden beneath clothes.
- 5. Turn both on.
- 6. Test audio level: about half on readout. 7 or 8 a good level.
- 7. Relax the presenter.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PRESENTER:

- 1. Look into camera lens. Smile.
- 2. Avoid movement that contacts with clothes as microphone is very sensitive.
- 3. Speak naturally.
- 4. 10 time frame. One take. Can pause when need break.
- 5. Time remaining reminder.
- 6. Relax.
- 7. Points to make.

Start by saying "My name is John Smith . . . etc

a. Background and upbringing: 3 minutes
b. Experiences in life – BEFORE meeting Jesus 2 minutes
c. The change that happened when met Jesus 1 minute
d. Life AFTER meeting Jesus 3 minute.
Finish by saying 'my name is John Smith, and that's my thread."

FINAL CHECKS:

- 1. Check battery capacity. Replace if necessary. (Flat must go on charger.)
- 2. Check which card to record to: A or B
- 3. NOTE; All other camera settings will be set ready to go.
- 4. RECORD: Red button on top red light comes on.
- 5. Give countdown to start speaking. 5-1

TO CHECK THE RECORDING:

- 1. Switch camera to "media"
- 2. The playout console is on the top of the camera.

TO FINISH:

- 1. When card is full, slide cover to left, double push and remove the card.
- 2. Download the contents to a portable hard drive via a mac laptop.

- 3. Keep cards out of light and heat. After downloading reformat the card.
- 4. REFORMATTING CARD:
 - a. Turn camera on.
 - b. Switch to "media'
 - c. Go to menu: Scroll down to XXXX & click.
 - d. Go right down to bottom "Format media" > A or B > Execute yes X2.

Set the white balance in the beginning of the shoot. Make sure get the participant to wear a dark or vibrant coloured top so that it stands out with the white background and lighting.
