Disinterested giving. it doesn't sound exciting, but it's one of the ways that we are able to be so successful in worldwide mission as a church. In addition to tithe, freewill offerings from members are essential in order to provide equitable support for the church's world work.

“Disinterested giving” is a term used when people give to the church and allow the organisation to distribute the offerings according to the worldwide needs. When offerings are given in a spirit of disinterested systematic benevolence, they nurture the sense of responsibility each member feels for the church's worldwide work, permit members to receive the blessing that regular and planned giving brings to the giver and ensure a steady flow of funds for all aspects of a balanced program.

Regularly, the GC receives a portion of our offerings via the divisions and redistributes the funds to mission entities. The World Mission Budget is on this list. It helps fund missionaries, hospitals, clinics, schools and churches. It also helps print literature and prepare broadcasts so that people who may otherwise never know of Jesus can hear or read about Him in their own languages.
