5. KEEP the SABBATH, preparing for it accordingly on Friday, keeping its limits, right thoughts and activities.
6. FAITHFULLY RETURN the Lord’s TITHE (10 percent of my income).
7. DEDICATE a regular percentage, of my own choice, of my income as a freewill OFFERING to the Lord.
