EARRING KIT ASSEMBLY

- 1. Sort the pieces into earring sets using the design guide included or refer to our website for a digital copy.
- 2. Glue the studs to the topper pieces ensuring you peel the protective plastic or paper off first.
- 3. Join any dual layered pieces together. Peel the protective paper/plastic first and the the adhesive side (shiny brown paper with blue writing) then line up the pieces and lightly join together. The adhesive is pressure sensitive so you can make slight adjustments before pressing down to form a permanent bond. (This only applies to kits with dual layered components)
- 4. Join the remaining pieces together using jump rings peeling remaining protective paper/plastic first.
- 5. When studs are dry, peel the front and attach to the rest of the earring with a jump ring.
- 6. Add a butterfly clasp and your earrings are complete!

HANDY TIPS!

- •When peeling iridescent pieces, be very careful to only peel the protective layer and not the iridescent film layer.
- •European birch pieces have paper applied. Sometimes, after removing the paper, some burn marks will remain but don't stress! A baby wipe or damp soapy cloth will easily remove them.
- •We recommend a gel type super glue such as Loctite Gel, Pattex Gel or E6000. Please ensure you use adequate ventilation and protective wear according to your glue instructions and allow long enough for the glue to cure completely.
- For clear printed studs, do not apply glue to the printed side, instead glue the stud to the non printed side as some glues can affect the printer inks causing them to bubble and dissolve.
- •When joining the jump rings, be careful not to scratch the earring parts with the open ends, especially on mirror or printed pieces.
- •Clean earrings with a soft non abrasive cloth.
