Course Description

The program provides learners and existing workers with skills and knowledge relating to work safely at heights in the resources and infrastructure industries. It includes identifying the work requirements, work procedures, and instructions for the task/s; accessing and installing equipment, performing work at heights and cleaning up the work area.

This course is recommended to be completed on a yearly basis to ensure currency of skill and knowledge

The assessment is conducted using a combination of methods; written questions and answers, group activities, and practical demonstration of skills.

Evidence of Identity (EOI)

- The combination of EOI documents **must contain your date of birth, current residential address, photograph and signature.**
- If you use more than one credit card, savings account card or statement, they must be from different financial institutions
- All documents provided **must contain your name in full, not just your initials.** The only exception is council rates notice
