



# CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry



## Course Description

This unit of competency specifies the mandatory work health and safety training required prior to undertaking construction work. The unit requires the person to demonstrate personal awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements in order to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others. It covers identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies. It also covers correctly selecting and fitting personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work

## Assessment Requirements

The assessment is conducted using a combination of methods; written questions and answers, group activities, and practical demonstration of skills.

## Evidence of Identity (EOI)

- The combination of EOI documents **must contain your date of birth, current residential address, photograph and signature.**
- If you use more than one credit card, savings account card or statement, they must be from different financial institutions
- All documents provided **must contain your name in full, not just your initials.** The only exception is council rates notice
